Marilyn R. McAfee, 80, of Camillus died unexpectedly Tuesday at Crouse Hospital following a brief illness. She was born in Syracuse and graduated from Onondaga Valley Academy in 1954 and lived in Camillus since 1964. She was predeceased by her husband Robert Sr. in 1985, her sisters Alice Seaman and Linda Ruckh and her parents "Hoddy" and "Betty" Seaman.

Marilyn's life was characterized by love, faith and a strong work ethic. Being the oldest of five children she was called on early in life to help with the daily tasks. At 16 she went to work for her father's trucking company until she was married and became a devoted homemaker. Years later she returned to work as a secretary at R.E. Dietz and later at Upstate Medical Center Research Foundation, retiring with 26 years of service. She assisted with Sunday school at The First Church of Christ, Scientist and volunteered in the reading room. In her later years she enjoyed several trips and holidays with family. Her time spent with her grandchildren was most precious. Her kindness compassion and giving nature will be missed by all who loved her.

Marilyn is survived by her sons Robert S. (Lucilia) McAfee, Jr. and Timothy B. (Danielle) McAfee; a brother Horace "Hod" (Nancy) Seaman, Jr.; a sister Carol Preising; and her beloved grandchildren Bryan, Dylan, Christine, and Jennifer; and several nieces and nephews.
