Alton G. "Al" Tallmadge, 101 of Camillus passed away peacefully at Van Duyn on June 10th, 2013. Born in Preble he graduated from Homer Academy, Syracuse University in 1936 where he played JV and Varsity Lacrosse where Roy Simmons, Sr. is quoted as saying "you are either damn good or damn lucky" and attended night school to earn his Masters in 1940.

Al worked at Split Rock School from 1936-40 where he met his wife Dorothy Park who was a teacher at Split Rock. He became an Administrator in 1940 at Solvay School district where he worked for 15 years and coached basketball for 11 years with a 93% winning record and 10 of 11 Division Championships. In 1955 he became Vice Principal of West Genesee High School and later Principal.

His dream was to start the first lacrosse team in CNY which he did at WG with used equipment donated by SU and Roy Simmons, Sr. Al retired in 1970 and is a life member of Onondaga County Retired Teachers' Assoc. He was a 32nd degree Mason and was a member of Tigris Temple Shrine and Crossroads Lodge # 520 for 69 years.

Al and Dorothy had spent winters in New Smyrna Beach, Fl and summers in the house they built in the Adirondack Mountains. He was predeceased by his daughter Joan Fletcher in 1994 and his wife of 65 years Dorothy in 2005.

Survived by his daughter Linda Tallmadge of Marcellus; a son-in-law Ronald Fletcher of Marcellus; five grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
