



B. Keith Bush

July 27, 1908 - December 2, 1998

Barton Keith Bush, 90, of Jordan died Wednesday at Community-General Hospital. Born in Jordan, he was a graduate of Jordan High School, Alfred University and the Cincinnati School of Embalming. He was a funeral director for 65 years. He and his brother, Kenneth L. Sr., ran the B.L. Bush & Sons Funeral Home in Jordan and Camillus from 1933 to 1969.

He was a member of the Camillus First Methodist Church and the Pitman Class of the church, and a member and past master of Jordan Lodge 386 and Sapphire Lodge 786. He was a 32nd Degree Mason. He was a 50 year member of the Camillus Lions Club; and a original member of the Camillus Historical Society, which preserved the Octagon House in Camillus; and a former member of the Camillus Village Board and the West Genesee School Board. His wife, Ruth M. (Mitchell), died in 1994.

SURVIVORS include Two daughters, Lois Wilson of Ocala, Fla., and Sarah E. Goodfellow of Tully; a son, Barton Conrad of West Falls; a sister, Rhoda B. Holt of Jordan; eight grandchildren; two great-grandchildren.
