Betty Ann Niles Schug, formerly of Syracuse and Camillus, New York, and most recently residing at Spring Meadows Trumbull, CT died on April 15, 2020, in Fairfield County, Connecticut. She was 92.

Born in East Syracuse, New York, on March 29, 1928, to the late Howard John and Beatrice Ann (nee Lashomb) Niles, Betty graduated from Goodyear Burlingame in DeWitt in 1947 and married the late Frederick K. Schug II that August.

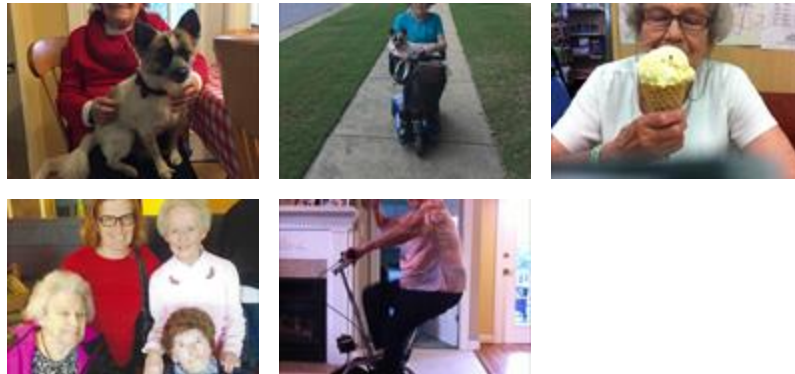
