



Carlyle W. Hackbarth

July 27, 1920 - February 21, 2016

Carl W. Hackbarth, 95, of Camillus, passed Sunday at Van Duyn. Born in Syracuse he was a 1937 graduate of Fayetteville High School and was a WWII decorated sergeant of the U.S. Army Air Force and received the New York State Conspicuous Service Star. Following the war he graduated from Syracuse University in 1948. Carl operated C.W. Hackbarth Accounting Service for over 55 years and was also the first comptroller for the Town of Camillus. He donated his professional services to a number of local organizations, including the Fairmount Fire Department and the Fairmount Nursery School. Carl was also an avid S.U. sports fan and had been a member of Fairmount Community Church since 1952. He was predeceased by his son, Eric, in 2005 and his wife of 60 years, Charlene, in 2007.

Carl is survived by two daughters, Christine Hackbarth of Syracuse and Patricia (Steven Little) Hackbarth of NYC, three grandchildren, Morgen (Jeremy) Millson, Serena (Richard) Shaughnessy, and Cynthia Little; and a great granddaughter, Natalya Bush.
