Carol Hunter George, 81, of Syracuse passed away peacefully on Thursday, December 24, 2015 and will be greatly missed by all who had the pleasure of knowing her. Carol was born to Loran and Jessie Hunter on January 29, 1934 and raised in Coleridge, NE. Carol was one of seven children and was predeceased by her parents and brother Donald.

She graduated from Coleridge High School and went on to attend Yankton College in South Dakota graduating with a degree in Theology. Carol married P.V. George on July 30, 1960 and they lived and served in churches in Vermont and New Hampshire for twenty years before moving to Syracuse to serve the Fairmount Community Church. Carol and P.V. were founding members of the Syracuse Habitat for Humanity. Carol was a member of the Plymouth Congregational Church in Syracuse. She served on the Onondaga County Commission of Aging. She had many interests including volunteering, gardening, and cooking.

She was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. Carol is survived by her loving husband of 55 years The Reverend P.V. George, two daughters Leela (Maria Polsinelli) and Sarah (Timothy Marchell) and three grandchildren Owen Marchell, Gracie Marchell and Anderson Marchell; her sisters Jean (Tony) Garcia, Lucille Olson, and brothers Gordon Hunter, Dayton (Susan) Hunter and Lowell (Karen) Hunter.
