Everett A. "Beefy" Campbell, 86 of Syracuse died Wednesday at Van Duyn. A life resident of Syracuse, Mr. Campbell was Marine Corp veteran having served with the 29th Marines, 6th Div. 2nd Battalion, Fox Co., in the Pacific during World War II. He received, among other honors, the Presidential Citation Award. He was honorably discharged from service in 1945. He drove truck for several firms after the war, and was a member of Local 317 Teamsters. He retired in 1982.
