



## Frederick T. DeLany III

October 3, 1933 - July 30, 2023

Frederick Thomas DeLany III, 89, of Camillus died on Sunday, 7/30/23 at Francis House. Born in Syracuse, he lived there until moving to Camillus in 1959, where he raised a family of nine children along with his wife Joanne Barrett DeLany.

He graduated from Christian Brothers Academy High School and later from the University of Notre Dame. Frederick then served as an officer in the United States Marine Corps. He spent his whole career in the construction industry. He was a communicant and former usher at St. Joseph's Church in Camillus. He was a member of Tuscarora Golf Club and a former board of directors member; also a former board of directors member of the Construction Employees Association and lastly, an Employer Trustee of numerous Union Trust Funds.

He was predeceased by his wife, the former Joanne K. Barrett on June 2, 2023, his eldest daughter, M. Colleen Kolakowski, as well as two sons who died at birth, Patrick and Daniel. He was also predeceased by one sister, Monica Fitzsimmons of Rochester, NY and one brother, Daniel J. DeLany of Mesa, AZ.

Frederick is survived by his five sons; Frederick J. of Syracuse, David B. of Camillus, Mark E. of Oswego, Timothy S. (Sally) of Camillus, Matthew J.

(Andrea) of Camillus; three daughters, Sheila A. Kubinski (Kevin) of Elmira, Erin of Syracuse and Shannon D. Bourcy (Scott) of Cape Vincent, NY; three grandsons and thirteen granddaughters; six great-grandchildren and one great-great grandchild; one brother George of Frederick, MD; and two sisters, Margaret DeLany of Camillus and Marianne Heesters of New Jersey.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated on Monday, August 7, 2023 at Noon in St. Joseph's Church. There will be no calling hours. Burial will be in St. Agnes Cemetery, Syracuse. Arrangements by B.L. Bush & Sons Funeral Home, Camillus.
