Harold M. Sherwood, 84, of Camillus, Lakeland, Phoenix and Canastota, NY and Tavares, FL died peacefully on May 9, 2016 in Tavares, FL. Born in Liberty, NY on July 18, 1931 he was the son of Robert and Julia Sherwood. After graduating from Liberty High School he attended Chillicothe Business College in Missouri. Following college he went to work for the CRI&P and the NYO&W railroads as station agent and telegraph operator. Hal served in the United States Navy from 1952 to 1956 where he served in the Korean Conflict as a Combat Air Crewman. After his tour of duty, Hal went to work for the General Electric Company where he worked on the development of the Atlas rocket guidance system. He retired from General Electric as the Manager of Production Control and Customer Service in 1988 after 32 years of service. Hal was a 13 year member of the Camillus Volunteer Fire Department and active in many golf and bowling leagues. On May 23, 1953, he married Jean O. Youmans of Prospect Park, NJ and had three children, Bill, Ken and Gail. An avid boater and fisherman he lived aboard his houseboat at Pirates' Cove during the summer and wintered in Tavares, FL with his companion Betty Markle.

Hal is survived by his wife Jean, his children Bill (Sue Katzoff), Ken (Pat Botsakos) and Gail (Bruce Finck); grandchildren Chris (Jamie), Jed (Samantha), Cambria, Jacob, Molly and Liam; great-grandchildren Seamus, Mackenzie and Cayden; two brothers Dan and Fred Sherwood; a sister
