



Henry "Hank" Wightman Jr.

Henry "Hank" Booth Wightman, Jr., 88, of Camillus, NY passed away Wednesday, December 18th at Upstate University Hospital, Syracuse, NY. He grew up in New Rochelle and Ithaca New York, and graduated from Syracuse University in 1955 and then served 2 years in the U.S. Air Force. He was employed by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation in the Finance Department for 30 years, retiring as Assistant Controller. The most treasured periods of his life were those spent at Big Moose Lake in the Adirondacks where his life revolved around family and friendships. He was a past president of the Board of Trustees of the Big Moose Community Chapel and past President of the Webb Property Owners Association. Hank was predeceased by his father Henry B. Wightman Sr., his mother Jocelyn W. Wightman, and his brother Frederick Wightman.
