Joan B. Doman, 83 of Granby, CT died Tuesday, May 20, 2003. Mrs. Doman was born on Manhattan Island the daughter of Anne (Lucas) and Bernard J. Hamilton, both of New York City. A graduate of University of Michigan in 1941, her diverse life included work for a Wall Street law firm, as journalist with Stamford (CT) Advocate, as teacher at Ridgefield High School in Connecticut, and several years living in Rome, Italy. A pilot and member of "The Ninety-Nines," pre-World War II women's organization that led to the WAFS, Women's Air Ferry Service. She was pre-deceased by her father-in-law Albert E.
