Lt. Colonel, Stanley Cooper, USAF Ret., 83, of Ft. Washington, MD on Monday, September 24, 2001 at Ft. Washington Hospital. Beloved husband of Carolyn H. Cooper; father of Douglas A. Cooper of Vienna, VA and Pamela L. Goodfriend of Denver, CO; son of the late Florence S. Cooper and Samuel Cooper; also survived by two grandchildren, Spencer Goodfriend and Sophie Lee Cooper; daughter-in-law, Barbara Bush Cooper; sister-in-law, Patricia Condon; niece, Deborah Condon.

Lt. Colonel Cooper served for 29 years in the Army Air Corps and Air Force and had tours of duty in the Phillipines during World War II, Guam and Okinawa during the Korean War, and Saigon during the Vietnam War. He worked five years in the Office of the Secretary of Defense and eight years in the Office of the Secretary of the Air Force. Lt. Colonel Cooper's last responsibility was Commander of the Command Services Unit at Bolling Air Force Base in Washington, DC. He retired in 1970. After his military service, Lt. Colonel Cooper became Professor of Business Management and later Chairman of the Business Department of Strayer College in Washington, DC. He retired from Strayer in 1980.

In addition to his family and career, Lt. Colonel Cooper's great passions in life were abstract art, golf and the stock market. Memorial services will be held at the Old Chapel, Ft.
