Margaret "Peggy" Ann (Roberts) Palmer, of Camillus, passed away peacefully on Saturday, August 1st, 2015 and will be greatly missed by all who had the pleasure of knowing her. “ *My sincerest condolences to all of you.*

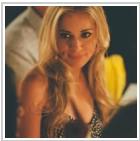
I am sorry I didnt respond sooner. I have been out of touch with things. I was shocked when I found out she had passed away. She was such a great lady. always had a smile for me.

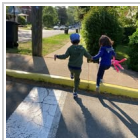
