



## Marjorie E. Nelson

October 11, 1924 - December 11, 2025

Marjorie Evelyn (Fitch) Nelson, 101, of Camillus, passed away peacefully at her home. Born on October 11, 1924, in Essex, Ontario, Canada, Marjorie—known to many as Marge—later became a proud U.S. citizen upon her marriage to Ralph A. Nelson in 1944. Together, Marge and Ralph raised their two children, Susan and Michael, living in Grosse Pointe Woods, Michigan, until relocating to Skaneateles, New York, in 1973.

Both Marge and Ralph worked at P&C Markets, where Ralph served as a vice president and Marge worked as a buyer. Active and engaged throughout her life, Marge was a proud golfer and longtime member of Skaneateles Country Club, as well as an avid Duplicate bridge player.
