Marty Johnson, 93 of Camillus died Saturday, January 15, 2004 at Van Duyn Home & Hospital. Born in Brooklyn he graduated from Brooklyn Technical High School and attended the Pratt Institute for 2 years. He worked as a Draftsman for Consolidated Edison Co. from 1930 to 1940 when he went into the Army and served as a 2nd Lieutenant during WWII. After his Army service he worked for Western Electric from 1943 to 1950 as a Draftsman and in 1950 he joined Reeves Instrument Division in Garden City, NY as a Design Draftsman and he retired from there in 1970 when he moved to Camillus. He was a 56 year member of Aurora Grata-Day Star Lodge #647 F&AM and Fairmount Community Church. He was predeceased by his wife the former Cora Wilder in 1996. Survived by three nieces Pat Ek, Carolyn Miller and Lynne McManus. Services are 10 am Tuesday at B.L. Bush & Sons Funeral Home, 10 Genesee Street, Camillus. Spring burial in N. Watertown Cemetery.
