Roger E. Kahn, 93, of Camillus, passed away peacefully on April 9, 2023. He was born in 1930 in Brooklyn to the late Roger C. and Irene (Liagre) Kahn. He served in Army Intelligence during the Korean War and was stationed in Germany. Returning home, he completed his architectural degree at Syracuse University in 1958. After graduation, he went to work for Sargent, Webster, Crenshaw and Folley Architects in Syracuse. He worked there continuously until the firm closed in 1993. During his retirement years, he loved to travel and spend time with relatives. He was on the board of the Fairmount Community Nursery School and devoted time to the Senior Empire State Games. Many people will remember Roger for his years organizing and running the Central New York AARP tax aide program.

He was predeceased by his first wife of 24 years, Camille (Dokulil).

He is survived by Nancy E. (Blakeslee) whom he married in 1984. He is also survived by his daughters: Colette (Bob) DeWitt of Rhinebeck, NY; Janine (Mitch) Winter of Pt.
