Terrance L. McBride, 69, of Victory passed away on Monday, December 4, 2023 from complications due to heart disease and diabetes. Born in Syracuse, he graduated from Tully High School in 1972. He had a lifelong interest in rabbits beginning at a very young age. He would raise and show rabbits locally, statewide, and nationally where he would even meet his future wife. He was a former officer in many local, state and national rabbit clubs and received many awards including person of year from the New York Rabbit & Cavy Breeders Association in 2010 along with his wife Janet.

He enjoyed racing and at one point was even a dirt track racecar driver. He was a longtime bowler, enjoyed SU sports, NY Giants, and the Yankees. Terry enjoyed traveling to many places including cruising. He loved fishing, boating and camping especially in Northern NY.
