Willard L. Mills, 84 of Southampton, NJ and formerly of Syracuse died in Pennsauken, NJ. Born in 1918 in Canton Center, CT, he married Dorothy Marks of Syracuse in 1949. She died in 1968 following a long illness and he later married Carol Storm Stewart in 1972, she died in 1999. He graduated from Bates College, Lewiston, ME in 1941, earned a second B.S. at Cleveland State University and an M.S. in Chemistry in 1964 from Syracuse University. He also studied chemistry at MIT. Mr. Mills worked as an industrial chemist from 1943-61 and as teacher at D'Youville College in Buffalo from 1964-65 and at Spring Garden College in Philadelphia from 1966-70. After that he was a substitute Math and science teacher in NJ public schools through 1979. Lastly he was computer laboratory coordinator at the Middlesex county college in Edison, NJ from 1979 until his retirement in 1984.. Mr. Mills was pre-deceased by his parents, wives, brother Orrin Mills and sister-in-law Marion Napier of Camillus. Survived by a sister Mary Humphrey; two step daughters Nancy Stewart and Carolyn Stewart Dyer; sister-in-law Robina Mills, Margaret Zimmer; nieces and nephews.
