William Arthur "Bill the Bomber" Rosecrans, 64, of Westvale passed away unexpectedly at home on March 26th, 2023. Bill was born in Deer Park, NY on December 31, 1958 to Nancy and Arthur Rosecrans. Bill was a 1977 graduate of West Genesee High School in Camillus, NY. He also graduated from Ithaca College in 1981 where he played football for the Ithaca Bombers. Bill worked for GHI insurance for several years. After he completed his Teaching Degree, Bill taught at Fowler High School for more than 20 years before retiring.
