William Edward "Butch" Whyland, 76, of Weedsport, passed away Tuesday the 26th of November. Born in Syracuse, Butch was a graduate of West Genesee High School. He went on to attend Arizona State University as well as Syracuse University. Butch was drafted into the United States Marine Corps where he faithfully served his country in Vietnam. Butch served his community as an Onondaga County Deputy Sheriff, Medic, volunteer firefighter and was one of the founding fathers of W.A.V.E.S. Ambulance Corp.
